

Weiss PSU102 Discrete Reference Power Supply

The factory supply, engineered for your Weiss DAC

The PSU102 is the supply Weiss built for its own DACs, engineered to the same standard as the rest of the Weiss line. One company designed both the DAC and the supply that feeds it, and one company stands behind both.



Engineered for this circuit, not to a general target

Weiss did not build a generic linear supply. The regulator is discrete, non-switching, and runs at high speed specifically to track the high-frequency load fluctuations the DAC's circuit presents, with low ESR capacitors and a toroidal transformer for low radiation. The company that designed the 204's circuit knows exactly what current demands that circuit makes, and tuned the supply's response to them. A third-party supply is engineered to a general target of clean and quiet power. That is good practice, but it solves the problem from the outside.

A universal supply, not a single-purpose box

The PSU102 output is selectable at 5V, 6V, 9V and 12V, rated to 1500mA across two high-quality Fischer sockets. It is built to power a range of high-end devices, not just one DAC. If you upgrade or add equipment, the supply keeps working for you, and it can run ahead of a future component rather than becoming a sunk cost tied to one box. A dedicated, fixed-voltage supply locked to a single model does not give you that.

Build you can see

The twin-frame construction places an inner stainless steel shield inside the anodized aluminum shell, with an oversized heatsink. Shielding a power supply against its own electromagnetic radiation matters when it sits inches from a DAC's analog output stage. It is a level of build quality you can see for yourself.

One brand, one standard, one point of accountability

Moving up to an outboard supply for a Weiss DAC is a step up into Swiss precision. The DAC and the supply share a single maker, a single warranty, and design decisions made to work together. If a problem ever comes up, there is no question of two makers pointing at each other's box. You bought a Weiss system, and Weiss stands behind the whole result.
